

1. CONNECT *Question of the Day. Highs and Lows. Share how last week's message influenced your week.*

If you could bring back any fashion trend, what would it be?
What is one way you saw God move in your life over the summer?

2. ENGAGE: SERMON REVIEW + DISCUSSION

Read the Scripture Passage . Recap of the Message.

- Read Matthew 9 together as a LifeGroup to catch the vision of this series. MOVED is how Fellowship will unleash compassion and hope in the world. This series will involve *vision*, *action*, and *financial* components.
- Read Exodus 17:8-16 together as a LifeGroup. God will do a great work, but we must be ready to fight!
- We learn an important lesson from this story: after God sets us free, the battle continues! But the enemy knows that if he can keep us from freedom, we won't ever give our lives away and won't make it to the Promised Land.

Discussion Questions

1. What stood out to you from this Sunday's sermon? As you re-read the passage from this Sunday, which part of Exodus 17:8-16 resonates the most?
2. Consider your life in light of the Israelites' experience in Exodus 17. Have there been moments in your experience when God set you free, but then you didn't see the Amalekites coming?
3. Albert brought the "Amalekites" onstage to show us their moves: discouragement, comfort, addiction, comparison, insecurity, others' opinions, your past, and your future. Which of these Amalekites targets you most frequently? Which do you struggle with the most? Why?
4. What does it mean to fight with our hands up? What does it mean to trust that God will be glorified in our fight?

3. APPLY: NEXT FAITHFUL STEP

- Which of the "Amalekites" – which of the enemy's moves – can you fight against this week? How can you encourage each other in your fight, holding one another's hands up just as Aaron and Hur held Moses' hands up?
- Joshua overcame the Amalekites with the sword, the Word of God. What is one way you can take action to listen to the voice of God, rather than the voice of the enemy, this week?

4. PRAYER

Take some time to hear prayer requests from each member of your LifeGroup. Pray together for the MOVED series, for your upcoming weeks together as a LifeGroup, and for God's ongoing work in and through you.
