**Title:** Invitation to Wonder

**1. CONNECT** *Question of the Day. Highs and Lows. Share how last week's message influenced your week.*

We learned about the hope, the call, and the sacrifice of the Kingdom in last week's message. What was one thing you sacrificed to participate in God's kingdom more fully this past week?

**2. ENGAGE: SERMON REVIEW + DISCUSSION**

*Read the Scripture Passage . Recap of the Message.*

Read Matthew 9:37-38 in the *New King James Version* as a LifeGroup:

*Then He said to His disciples, "The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few.*

*Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest."*

Pastor Albert shared that God extends three invitations to us as His Church: (1) Wonder; (2) Action; (3) Sacrifice.

**Discussion Questions**

1. As you reflect on your faith journey, think about your most recent engagement of sacrifice and action that led you to experience God's wonder. Share this aloud with each other.
2. As Pastor Albert calls us to experience God's wonder through sacrifice and action in the next two years, what initiative from the MOVED campaign resonates with you the most (Multiply the Movement, Oppose Injustice, Value Kids, Expand our Ministries, Declare the Gospel)? Why?
3. Pastor Albert said that in order for us to experience wonder, we have to be able to leave the cheap seats of our faith. What "cheap seats" are you needing to leave in your life that are keeping you from wonder?
4. As you hear the statement, "The Church of Jesus Christ is the hope of the world. The Church is Plan A, and there is no Plan B," how can you receive God's hope in your life this week? How can you be a part of bringing Christ's hope to the world this week?

**3. APPLY: NEXT FAITHFUL STEP**

Our MOVED series casts vision for how Fellowship can unleash compassion and hope in the world. Pastor Albert asked, "What can you give?" and "What can you do?" Share one way you can "give" or "do" specifically in this season to ultimately experience God's wonder more fully.

**4. PRAYER**

Take some time to hear prayer requests from each member of your LifeGroup. Pray together for the MOVED series, for your upcoming weeks together as a LifeGroup, and for God's ongoing work in and through you. Pray for what God may be asking you to sacrificially give over the next two years.
