2. Engage: Sermon Review + Discussion

This week Albert preached the greatest story of the greatest gift, Jesus. To live out the Gospel fully we must have a passion, a place and a promise. A passion for the greatest story and a passion for the people who've yet to hear the Gospel. A safe place in the church where we can be reminded of who we are and who's we are in Christ, and a promise we believe in and rest in with our whole heart.

1. Sometimes we try to "pay off" our sin with good behavior .But on our best day, our own righteousness will always come up short. Do you ever find yourself trying to "pay off" the gift freely given to you in Christ?
2. Jesus didn't just pay your debt, he gave you his righteousness. What does it look like for you to freely make withdrawals from his righteousness daily?
3. Prince himself walked door-to-door sharing the Gospel! What might be getting in the way of you sharing your passion for the Gospel with others? Awkwardness? Uncertainty?
4. Belief in God is when you trust all of God with all of you. Does your trust look like rest? Full rest? Does Jesus have your "full weight"? Are you bringing everything to him? What are you still holding onto?
5. Is your church and your church community a place where you are able to drop off what's too heavy for you to carry? Is it a place where your face is lifted up? How does inviting people into this community reflect the character of Jesus?

7. What would it look like for your heart to break for those who've yet to hear the story of the Gospel?
