

The song "Here Us" was birth out of prayer time of the song writer Aaron Lindsey. This song starts with adoration and acknowledgement of God, and it ends with "The Lord's Prayer".

As you listen to the song, we invite you to go on a journey with us for a week as we lean into this powerful prayer. Each day's reflection includes a brief explanation, a related Bible verse, a question and a prayer. Feel free to adjust the schedule according to your preference or spend more time on any particular section that resonates with you.

The Lord's Prayer is found in the New Testament of the Bible, specifically in the book of Matthew (Matthew 6:9-13) and Luke (Luke 11:2-4). Let's take a deeper look at each line of the Lord's Prayer:

Day 1 "Our Father, who art in heaven."

SONG LYRICS: "OUR GOD, YOU HAVE ALWAYS BEEN OUR GOD."

Explanation

Acknowledging God as our Heavenly Father establishes a personal and loving relationship with Him. It reminds us that we are His children, and He cares deeply for us.

Verse

"Pray then like this: 'Our Father in heaven...'"

-Matthew 6:9

Question

How have we acknowledged God as Father in our lives? How have we seen the Father care deeply for us?

Prayer

Heavenly Father, I come before You with thanksgiving and awe, knowing that You are a loving and caring Father. Thank You for adopting me into Your family and for Your constant presence in my life. Thank you for calling me your own.

Day 2 "Hallowed be thy name."

SONG LYRICS: "SO WE PRAY THESE THINGS, IN THE MIGHTY NAME, THE NAME ABOVE ALL OTHER NAMES."

Explanation

This line emphasizes the holiness and greatness of God's name. It calls us to reverence and honor Him in all aspects of life.

Verse

"Let them praise your great and awesome name! Holy is he!"

-Psalm 99:3

Question

How does my life glorify God's name?

Prayer

Holy and majestic God, Your name is above all names, and I praise You with all my heart. Help me live in a way that brings honor to Your name and reflects Your character to the world.

Day 3 "Thy kingdom come."

SONG LYRICS: "YOUR KINGDOM COME."

Explanation

By praying for God's kingdom to come, we express our hope and desire for His rule and reign to be established on Earth.

Verse

"Your kingdom come..."

-Matthew 6:10a

Question

Take a moment and look, where do see God's rule and reign at work in your life?

Prayer

Lord, may Your kingdom come in my heart, my family, my community, and the entire world. I surrender to Your authority and seek to advance Your kingdom through my actions and words.

Day 4 "Thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven."

SONG LYRICS: "YOUR WILL BE DONE, ON EARTH AS IT IS IN HEAVEN."

Explanation

Submitting to God's will means aligning our desires and decisions with His divine purpose, seeking His guidance in all circumstances.

Verse

"...Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven."

-Matthew 6:10b

Question

How am I aligning my life to God's purpose and plan?

Prayer

Gracious Father, I submit my will to your divine will. Lord help me discern Your will for my life and grant me the courage and strength to follow it faithfully. May my life reflect Your perfect will as I strive to live in obedience to your holy word.

Day 5 "Give us this day our daily bread."

SONG LYRICS: "GIVE US THIS DAY, OUR DAILY BREAD."

Explanation

This line reminds us to trust God for our daily needs, both physical and spiritual, recognizing that He is the ultimate provider.

Verse

"Give us this day our d aily bread..."

-Matthew 6:11

Question

How have you seen God provide for you and your family?

Prayer

Lord, You know my needs even before I ask. I trust in Your provision, both materially and spiritually. Help me rely on You daily and find contentment in Your sufficiency.
